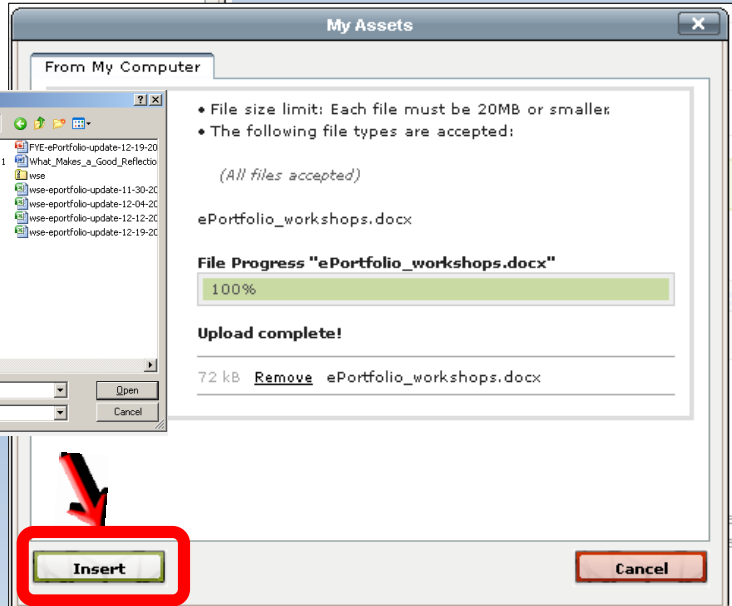
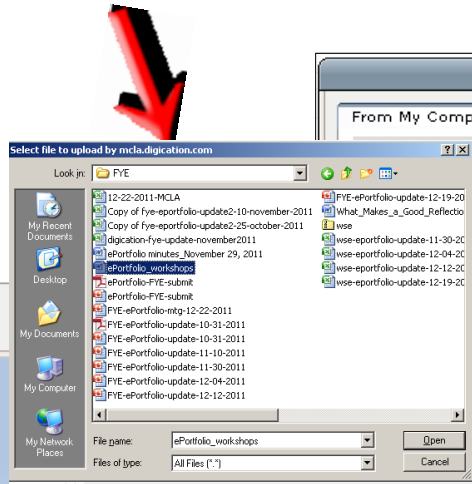




To upload a **document**, first **highlight** the target text, then click the **Insert File** button on your text editor toolbar.

also says (316d–317b) that while the activity of sophistry has been practised by poets and other experts from
ancient times, he is the first person to have openly proclaimed himself a “sophist” and claimed to teach people
(sc. how to achieve success in life); he thus claims for himself recognition of his professional status in a role,
that of teacher of human excellence as a means to success in life, which was traditionally claimed by the poets.
