### Who are these degree programs designed for?

- Adult learners who are balancing work and family.
- Applicants with an Associate Degree. Students with 45-60 credits may also be eligible.

### How are the degree programs structured?

- Flexible evening schedule, one night per week.
- Students can complete in just over two years with year round classes.
- Unique balance of face-to-face, hybrid, and online courses in 8 week formats.
- Prior learning credits are available for work and life experience.
- Cohort style learning model where students progress through the outlined program of studies together.
