## **NOTES FOR PSYCHOLOGY AND CORE REQUIREMENTS:**

- note 1 Psychology courses carrying core Self & Society credit (PSYC100 and PSYC230) may not be used to meet both Department and Core requirements.
- note 2 Upper division psychology elective courses are listed in the current college catalog, along with their specific prerequisites. Students may use only one *Directed Study* psychology course (PSYC391, PSYC470, PSYC496, PSYC500) to fulfill the upper level psychology elective requirement in the major. Additional *Directed Study* courses may be used as electives toward general graduation requirements.
- Registration for PSYC550, Senior Thesis, is by special arrangement with a faculty member. It requires completion of a formal thesis on a significant topic in psychology. Intended for senior psychology majors, a literature review and proposal, along with approval of two members of the
