Program Requirements

- Earned Associate's degree (A.A. or A.S.) from a State University of New York (SUNY) institution
- 2.5 GPA

Program Benefits

- Maximizes transfer credits to provide students with a clear plan to complete a general education transfer block.
- Automatic satisfaction of most core curriculum requirements for the potential of 60 transfer credits. (MCLA will require completion of a senior level capstone class and a physical education course.)

ADMISSION PROCESS

APPLY

- Complete MCLA Transfer Application online www.mcla.edu/transfer

SUBMIT

- Official college transcripts from each institution attended
- FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) if you are applying for financial assistance

REVIEW

- A Transfer Credit Analysis (TCA) showing how your previous credits apply to an MCLA degree will be sent to you at the time of acceptance.

- Submit your deposit to secure your enrollment at MCLA!
