Probation partners with local law enforcement and human service agencies to keep communities safe and provide a wealth of programs, initiatives, and resources, such as substance abuse counseling and educational and job training. The agency collaborates on a regular basis with Federal, state, and local police, Sheriff's Departments, Parole Board, Sex Offender Registry Board (SORB), State agencies such as the Department of Mental Health (DMH), Department of Transitional Assistance (DTA), Department of Children and Families (DCF), and the Department of Youth Services. Probation also works closely with local schools. They also update and maintain Court Activity Record Information (CARI) and the Civil Restraining Order Registry. The agency screens applicants during the court intake process to determine eligibility for a court-appointed attorney. The agency is also charged with the sealing of records. Any MCLA students interested in criminal justice will find this an exceptionally outstanding opportunity.
